04 November 2024



Ambassador Geela attended a reception hosted by Her Excellency Aiga Liepina, Ambassador of Latvia to commemorate their National Day.



The event was attended by more than 40 female Ambassadors and diplomats to Belgium and EU.

Ms Florence Raes, Director UN Women Brussels Office in her remarks highlighted the need for strengthened collaborative efforts to combat violence against women and girls noting the alarming fact that 1 woman is killed every 10 minutes and the rising sexual violence in conflicts by 50%.




Ambassador Geela participates in the International Conference “Children’s Rights at a Crossroads: Evolving Humanitarian Crises” held in Brussels.

22 November 2024

The event was organized by the Belgian Foreign Ministry, UNICEF Belgium and Plan International Belgium to commemorate the 35th anniversary of the Convention on the Rights of the Child. The opening address was given by Her Majesty the Queen of the Belgians in her capacity as an Advocate for the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

Four thematic areas that were discussed in working groups, included

- Children and armed conflict,
- The climate crisis is a children’s rights crisis,
- Girls in crises- addressing their specific needs and
- Mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS) in emergencies with reflections on current domestic and international contexts.

In the opening remarks of the new chair of the delegation, His Excellency Serban-Dimitrie Sturdza (MEP) from the European Conservatives and Reformists Group, he reassured commitment to further the existing inter-parliamentary ties between the delegation of the European Parliament and the members of the South Asian countries. Ambassador Geela also reiterated the Government of Maldives commitment to further expand cooperation with the European Union and its institutions especially in the areas of trade, investment, environment and climate change.




Ambassador Geela attends a meeting between OACPS SIDS Ambassadors and the Permanent Representative of Ireland to the European Union
