Ambassador Geela met with Her Excellency Aiga Liepiņa, Ambassador of Latvia to Belgium.

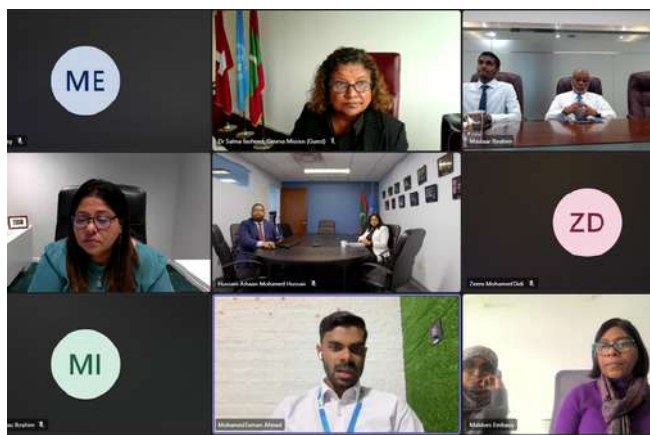
The Ambassadors discussed expanding cooperation in the areas of higher education and health sectors of the two countries.

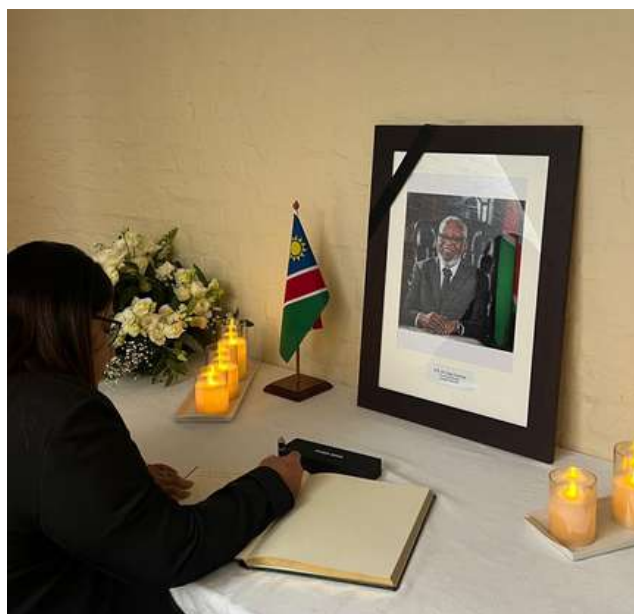


Ambassador Geela signs the book of condolence of the Founding President of Namibia, Dr. Sam Shafiishuna Nujoma.

Ambassador Geela conveyed sincere felicitations to the people and the Government of Kuwait on the occasion.

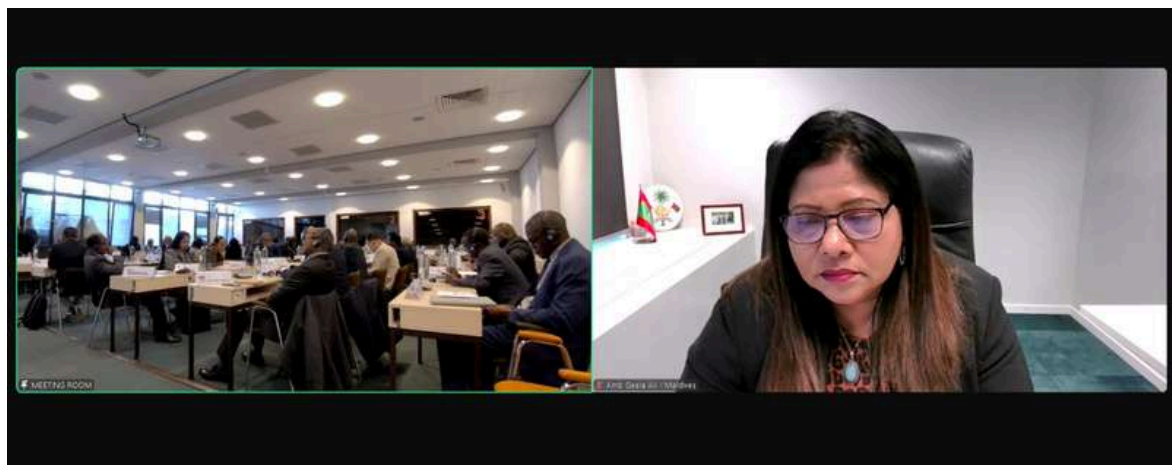


Ambassador Geela meets with the Ambassadors of Bhutan and Sri Lanka

Ambassador Geela participated in a special meeting of the Committee of the Ambassadors of the Organization of African, Caribbean and Pacific States (OACPS).

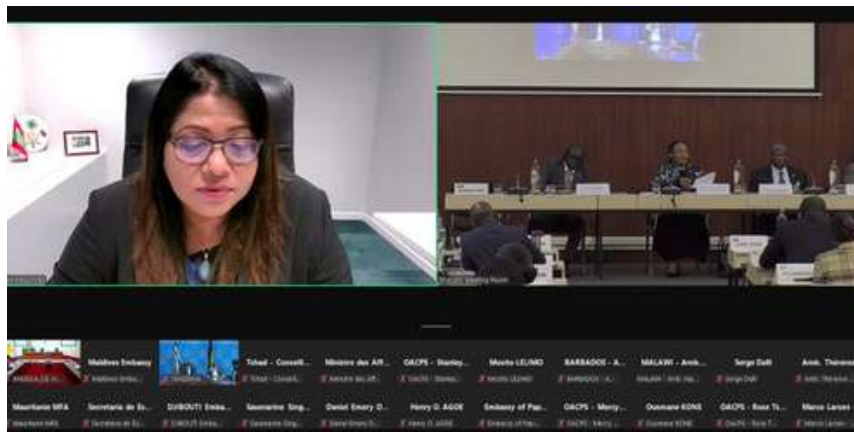
During the meeting, the Ambassadors evaluated the nominations for the post of Secretary General of the organization for the period 2025-2030.
